



Heygreen Citizenship and Charity Overview 2024/25

Each year group will plan an awareness day/event and support a class charity. This should be planned in advance and shared with parents/carers and staff at least 2 weeks in advance. Class teachers of each year group will be in charge of sharing plans with staff and sending messages to parents in advance.

The school council representative from each year group will be in charge of counting the amount of money raised and sharing the total in celebration assembly.

The class teachers of each year group will be in charge of putting together a social media post to share what went on during the awareness day.

- 1 Select a charity and update display.**
Classes should choose a class charity and its linked awareness day.
- 2 Plan a date and event.**
Ensure your class charity day is in the school calendar and you are aware of any resources that will be needed for your event.
- 3 Class Planning Session**
This must take place at least **3 weeks before** your event. This session will be planned by the class teacher and will give children information about the class charity and be an opportunity to plan/make posters. Ensure Amy is aware of day.
- 4 Parent and Carer Information**
Parent and Carer information will need to be sent out at least **2 weeks prior** to the event. This should be sent to Amy by the class teacher to send to all parents of those involved across the school.
- 5 Charity Event**
On the day of the event, the class in charge should arrange for the money to be collected from each class. This should then be counted and a total given to the office.
